Jackson County Water is implementing a new policy regarding new services. Standard installations will remain priced at \$2500. However, there will now be a fee for providing a tap estimate for new services. The fee will be \$200, but that amount will be applied to the cost of the service.

This will cover the up-front cost of preparing the estimate, but the customer will get credit for the fee when purchasing the tap. In this way, serious inquiries and subsequent tap purchases will ultimately not be impacted by the fee.

A new service installation will consist of a $\frac{3}{4}$ " meter setting and meter. The meter and setting will be housed in a 30" deep underground enclosure. A section of $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pipe size (3/4" O.D.) polyethylene water line will be installed from the meter setting. You or your contractor can connect your water line at this point. Jackson County Water recommends using a $\frac{3}{4}$ " brass compression fitting to make this connection.

Jackson County Water requires the customer to have installed a shut-off valve, a pressure reducing valve and a check valve in their service line at some convenient location past the meter setting.

The fixtures (meter, meter base, enclosure, etc) that are installed by Jackson County Water are the property of Jackson County Water. However, you or your contractor can turn on the water service when you have finished your installation, or you may call our office and we will dispatch someone to turn it on for you.

The final desired location of the meter will be determined prior to installation, As always, unforeseen factors in the field during construction may require adjusting the final location of the service.
